Introducing Army Sergeant— James Pope

Jim was born in Indianapolis, IN on February 8, 1943. Indy was the first major city to occur in the United States. Where Jim's parents owned a little grocery store and they lived in the back. Jim started working at the family grocery store at the age of six stocking pop bottles. As he grew older he continued to work there saving his money in hopes of one day buying his own car. One of his best memories was getting his driver's licenses. This gave him independence to get around town on his own. A few months later, Jim bought his first car, a 1954 Ford Crestline.

Jim's sister, who is nine years older, had a boyfriend whom Jim was fond of. He was in the service and encouraged Jim to join. So in 1966 Jim joined the Army and was sent to Vietnam. He was there during the worst time of the War. Jim was in a hole when his platoon was attacked by the Viet Cong. Fighting continued for 30-mintues and Jim's hole was hit by mortar. Everyone around him was dead. Jim quickly grabbed the machine gun and begun returning fire killing 30 Viet Cong. The body count was 608 that night. However, Jim suffered no physical injuries, but the sounds and memories of that night left him with severe PTSD.

He left Vietnam and the Army in June 1968. He has received several badges and medals such as the Combat Infinitary Badge (CIB), Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry and the Silver Star. When Jim got out he signed up for the reserves and served four years. During this time he was sent to Baltimore, during a period of civil unrest, to control the streets where burning and looting of local businesses took place.

Jim joined Post 2093 in 1969 at a time when most VFW Post members really did not want any Vietnam War Veterans to join. Jim has served as Commander twice, Sr. Vice and on the House Committee for many years. He is also known as "Big Daddy" because he adopts and mentors the younger men in the Post. You will find a barstool where a plaque on the bar bears his name for all of the many things and contributions he has made to the Post, this is his favorite spot in the canteen. He enjoys the socialization with members of our Post.

When Jim is not driving someone to the VA or to the airport one of his favorite past time things is going the gun range. He doesn't go as often as he likes because the range is 50 miles away. It's an outside shooting range and he enjoys having someone to go with him. Jim also stays in contact with several of his comrades and enjoys talking with his CO every week.

Jim has been blessed with three children, two girls and one boy; and we are lucky to have a friend in him.

Remember our Post survives on Volunteers. In 2021, please consider doing your part. Do what you can. When you can. We have many **opportunities** where <u>YOU</u> can make a difference. Just let the Bartender or Post Officer know you want to volunteer and they will match you with what we need now or in the near future.
